Subjects

English: Author Study, Biography and Autobiography, Journalistic Writing, Argument, Stories which raise issues/dilemmas, Newspaper Recounts and Plays.

Mathematics: Counting and understanding number; Addition and Subtraction; Multiplication and Division; Fractions; Measure; Geometry and Statistics.

Science: Light, Animals Including Humans, Electricity, Living Things & Their Habitats, Evolution & Inheritance.

Guided Reading: Grammar and Reading Comprehension focus. Preparation for SATs. Whole class reading.

Computing – E-Safety, Research Skills, Word Processing Skills.

History — The Census, Britain During WWII, People Featured on Banknotes.

Geography — Population Changes, Energy and Climate Change, Fieldwork Skills.

R.E. – Loving, Vocation & Commitment, Expectations, Sources, Unity, Death and New Life, Witnesses, Healing, Common Good, Islam and Judaism.

Art – Painting, Mixed Media (Artist Study), Sculpture (Making Memories), Craft & Design (Photo Opportunities).

Design & Technology –

Structure (Playgrounds), Mechanical Systems (Automatic Toys), Cooking & Nutrition (Come Dine With Me)

P.E. — Dance, Rugby, Netball, Athletics, Football, Basketball, Tennis, Cricket.

Music – Performance, improvisation, musical notation, composers and musicians, history of music.

Independence

This year, we will be encouraging the children to be independent and responsible learners.

SATs



During the Summer Term, Year 6 will sit SATs exams in:

Mathematics

1x Arithmetic – 30 Minutes (40 Marks)

2x Reasoning – 40 Minutes (35 Marks each)

There will be multiple practice papers for the children to feel comfortable with the content and the structure of these tests.

The SATs are due to take place:

Monday 13th May 2024 – Thursday 16th May 2024

English

1x Reading Comprehension – 60 Minutes (50 Marks)

1x SPaG (Spelling & Grammar) – 45 Minutes (50 Marks)

1x Spelling (20 Marks)

Home Time and Mobile Phones
